LATIN AMERICA LAUNCHES

These new tours in Latin America are bound to set clients' hearts racing, finds **Alice Barnes-Brown**



BELIZE, BUT BETTER

Travelling from south to north, Latin Routes' Luxury Belize itinerary traverses the Central American country in style. The 10-day tour is based in three places. Clients acclimatise in the Toledo district, at Copal Tree Lodge, with an infinity pool overlooking the canopy and a sustainable farm. Placencia's powdery sands and the fauna-filled Monkey River are next, before a visit to paradisiacal Ambergris Caye. A scenic flight over the spectacular Great Blue Hole ends the trip on a high.

Book it: The 10-night itinerary starts at £7,299 for departures between June and November, including flights, 23 meals, activities and tours. latinroutes.co.uk

CITIZEN SCIENCE IN COLOMBIA

Culture-packed plazas, palm-tickled shores and coffee plantations: Colombia has it all. Exodus Adventure Travels' Best of Colombia itinerary begins in Medellín – once the home of drug lord Pablo Escobar, now an innovation hub. The group then flies to the Caribbean coast to visit an Indigenous village. This November, a special 'citizen science' itinerary allows guests to take water samples at the Finca La Jorará ecohotel, which helps experts identify species living in the ecosystem.

Journey Latin America's Magdalena River Cruise: Colombia's Hidden Gems trip has its first departure in May 2025. Clients will enjoy a pre-cruise stay in vibrant Cartagena before boarding the new AmaMagdalena. The cruise will visit several wildlife reserves along the river basin and historic town Palenque, ending with two nights in Tayrona National Park. Costa Rica's gentle shores, wonderful wildlife and easy-breezy vibes make it ideal for all ages – and Intrepid Travel's Best of Costa Rica Family Holiday takes in some of its most interesting places. Parents and kids can bond over chocolate-making classes with Indigenous Térraba families along the eponymous river, spot sloths from swinging rope bridges in Monteverde's cloud forest and see endangered green sea turtles in Tortuguero National Park.
